ELIZABETH COX

State of South Carolina {  
 Pendleton District { In the name of God Amen know ye that  
 I Elizabeth Cox of the State & District Aforesaid being convinced  
 of Mortality and reduced by affliction into a low state of  
 health but of sound mind & memory do this Day Constitute &  
 Ordain this my last will and testament hereby rendering void  
 all former Wills & Testaments by me made (VIZ) recommending my  
 Soul to God the Giver & my Body to the dust from whence it Came  
 do direct that my Body Shall be Buried in a decent & Christian  
 Manner and that my property shall be distributed in the follow-  
 ing manner (viz) I will & bequeath to my son James Cox one Bay  
 horse which I now have in my possession Named Jack to him &  
 his Heirs forever Also to my Grandaughter Elizabeth Cox Daugh-  
 ter of John Cox My Own Bed & Furniture (viz) Two Sheats two pil-  
 lows and one Bedquilt To my Grandaughter Lucinda Riley I will  
 & Bequeath My Other Bed & Furniture viz) Two Sheats two pillow  
 & One Bedquilt to them and their hiers forever to my Son John  
 Cox I will & Bequeath one pewter Dish & Six plates to him &  
 his Hiers for ever it is also my Desire that my Bay mare Should  
 be Sold on a Credit of Twelve Months & that my son John Cox  
 Should get the third part of the purchase money of said mare  
 & the Ballance and the Ballance of said money is to be eaually  
 Devided between all my legatees except James Simes, Charles White,  
 & Holingsworth Aandson and my desire is that they should each  
 have five Shillings out of my estate & to have no shear or part  
 of any thing else I also wish that my plantation & tools Bal-  
 lance of Household Furniture Cows & Calves and other Cattle &  
 my hogs all Sold at a twelve Months Credit and the money Aris-  
 ing from said Sail to be eaually divided between all my le-  
 gatees except as above excepted also it is my desire that my  
 Thirty Dollars of money I have in the hands of Benjaman Dickson  
 Should be got by the legatees or Executors and pay to James Sims,  
Davis M<sup>c</sup>Cutchin, Henry Cox, Gambrel Cox & Nimrod Bartlet the sum  
 of two dollars 69 Cents each and the ballance if Any to go to  
 my son John & Ja<sup>s</sup> Cox It is my wish that my son James Cox  
 should have the whole of the Crop groing on my place to him &
