WILLIAM COX

In the Name of God Amen I William Cox of pendleton District and State of South carolina Do Make and ordain this My Last will and Testament Revoking all others, In the first place I Leave all my Depts to be punctually paid and the legacies hereinafter Bequathed are to be Dicharged as Soon as Circumstances will permit and in the Manner Directed

Item to My Dearly beloved wife Mary Cox I give and Bequath a Sufficiency of my Estate to Support her During her Natural Life

Item- give and Bequath unto William Bolen Cox and John Wesley Cox the plantation on track of land whare I NOW Live to be Equal-ly Devided between ^{them} Boath

all the Rest of My property I Leave to be Equally Devided between the Rest of my Children Exoept Garner Brooks I Laave him Nothing but his Son william tomson Broocks I Leave him a Equal Shear with the Rest of the last mentioned Children Lastly I Constitute and appoint Richard Madden and ISaac Sleat my Executors of this my Last will and testament in witnefs of an each of these things here mentioned and Contained I have Set my hand and seal
